



INDIANA ANGUS ROYALTY CONTEST

This contest was created to provide an avenue for young ladies to promote the Angus Breed, promote beef consumption, and the beef industry in general. A list of eligible girls from the IJAA will receive invitations to participate and contest rules and guidelines

Eligibility

- ◆ Indiana Junior Angus Princess: Ages 9 - 13, Indiana Angus Princess: Ages 14 - 18, and Indiana Angus Queen: Ages 16 - 20
- ◆ A member, in good standing, of the Indiana Junior Angus Association
- ◆ Past Recipient

Qualifications:

- ◆ Candidates must have been active members of the Juniors Association for the past three years and have a record of showing Angus cattle in Indiana
- ◆ Candidates are expected to respect dress attire guidelines and follow the Code of Conduct as set by Miss American Angus

Requirements:

- ◆ Complete Royalty Application
- ◆ *Indiana Junior Princess Candidates:* Present a poster to the Queen Committee that displays all aspects of her involvement with cattle (care, management, shows, educational opportunities, promotion, etc.). Be willing to answer simple questions about your Angus cattle
- ◆ *Indiana Princess Candidates:* Submit an essay (no more than 200 words) to the Queen Committee explaining why she would like to be the Indiana Angus Princess. Be willing to answer questions about your essay.
- ◆ *Indiana Angus Queen Candidates:* Create and present a speech (not to exceed three (3) minutes) on one of the following topics: 1.) Promotion of the Angus Breed organization, 2) Promotion of Beef Consumption, 3.) Any subject relating to the Beef Industry, or 4.) How I will promote Beef as the Indiana Angus Queen. The speech will be given to all members attending the annual Indiana Angus Association Meeting in December.

Dollar Amount:

- ◆ \$500.00 paid directly to the Indiana Angus Queen.
- ◆ \$250.00 paid directly to each of the Indiana Angus Princesses
- ◆ Tiaras, Banners, and Flowers will also be awarded. Banners are to be returned at the end of the reign

Royalty will represent our breed and appear to present ribbons at the Indiana Preview shows, the State Fair 4-H and Open Show, the NJA show, Indiana Angus District Shows, and county fairs upon request
