- ◆ Applicant must be accepted and enrolled in post high school education
- ◆ First-time Recipient
- ◆ Past Recipient, if no other applicants

Required Attachments:

- ◆ Submit a copy of high school transcript or spring semester college transcript
- ◆ Submit a copy of college or trade school spring semester class schedule
- ◆ Submit a recent picture
- ◆ Completed *Application*
- ◆ Submit an Essay. The essay should include PAST information about your herd, shows and family; the PRESENT status of your life and your Angus connections, awards, activities, and experiences, and the FUTURE goals for your life

Dollar Amount:

- ◆ \$750.00 paid directly to recipient upon proof of successful completion fall semester of post-secondary education

Scholarship does not automatically renew. Applicants must reapply.

Recipients are strongly encouraged to attend a SIAA meeting to give a brief acceptance speech and meet the SIAA members.
