2023 Advanced Education Scholarship Application

To assist more Indiana Junior Angus members with their college educations the Indiana Angus Auxiliary is offering two scholarships to upcoming college sophomores, juniors, or seniors. We will award a \$250 scholarship to one girl and a \$250 scholarship to one boy. If we do not have any applicants of one gender, we will award two scholarships to juniors of the same gender.

The following criteria will be observed in choosing the recipients:
Applicants must have been members of the Indiana Junior Angus Association, for at least 3 years. If asked, they must show proof of membership.

Required Attachments:

- **Submit a copy of spring semester college transcript**
- **Submit proof of continued enrollment in college, university, technical or trade school**
- **Submit proof of IJAA membership**
- **Completed scholarship application**

These scholarships are not automatically renewed with the Indiana Angus Auxiliary, but any junior may re-apply. Juniors can receive this scholarship award no more than two times. Winners must show proof of being a college student in your second, third, or fourth year.

Late applications will be refused. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, applications must be postmarked/emailed prior to the deadline.
